

PLASTIC CARE AND CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

Plastic material is sensitive to many different chemicals which are found in everyday household products. We hope that the following care and cleaning guide will help ensure the durability of your new product.

DO

You can clean your items with a soft cloth (we recommend a soft microfibre cloth), a mild soap solution (dishwashing liquid) and lukewarm water. Apply only light pressure and only use a clean cloth to prevent surface scratches. For extra clean and shine, you can use a cleaner which is specifically recommended for use with plastics like Vuplex™ Plastic Anti-Static Cleaner which is available from our website.

DON'T

Never use the same cloth that you clean other household items with. There may be remaining residue and chemicals which can damage the plastic.

Do not use window cleaner, alcohol or ammonia products (commonly used in many all-purpose household cleaners), chemical sprays, solvents, thinners or abrasive cleaners. These products can cause a variety of problems including but not limited to, the plastic going cloudy/opaque, stress crazing and surface scratching.

Do not use abrasive pads, stiff brushes, paint scrapers or razor blades. Even paper towels may cause slight surface scratches.

Do not apply any adhesive tape direct to the surface or edges of plastic material as this will be difficult to remove and will cause damage.

Do not use polythene products including cling film and polybags as they may cause surface crazing.

WARNING

The list of above items are by no means every item which can cause damage to the material therefore it is essential to always check a product's suitability before use.
